24 November – 2 December 2011 Trade mission to Papua New Guinea (PNG)

Trade and Investment Queensland invites you to participate in a trade mission to Port Moresby and Lae. This mission will coincide with the PNG Chamber of Mines and Petroleum Seminar Sessions from 29 November to 2 December 2011.

If there is sufficient interest from Queensland's sports business sector to target the PNG 2015 Pacific Games, a one-day program will be developed for 25 November 2011. Participation will enable your company to take advantage of Trade and Investment Queensland's strong government-to-government and government-to-industry links in PNG.

The mission will focus on:

- mining: equipment, technology, and services
- infrastructure: transport, roads, port, airport, water and sanitation development
- building and construction
- vocational training: all sectors
- information and communication technology (ICT)
- food and catering services
- sports business.

Why participate in this trade mission?

PNG is a major destination for knowledge-intensive exports and has a substantial business relationship with Queensland. The PNG economy continues to experience growth driven by its resource sector, which is providing export opportunities for Queensland. Queensland also enjoys long-established links with PNG underpinned by a Memorandum of Understanding that has been in place since 1992.

Participation in the mission will provide you with an insight on project opportunities in the mining, food and catering services, training services, building and construction, ICT and infrastructure sectors.

The mission program will give you an opportunity to meet potential business partners, distributors, and key government and industry players. You will benefit from the government's existing relationship with the PNG business community, in-market allies and government contacts.

Trade mission participants will:

- attend networking functions, with the opportunity to invite key business contacts to attend these events
- receive detailed briefings on doing business in PNG, particularly Lae
- attend briefings on targeted projects by major companies and/or government departments
- participate in appropriate site visits where possible.
